Also, the OPP have informed us that they will be laying charges to people driving golf carts on the highway.

Please make sure that your grass is cut. If you are away make arrangements with someone to have it cut. If this task is neglected we will do it for you at your expense.



Just a reminder that bikes should not be ridden after dark. Also, please ensure that your children are on their own site by 11:00pm quiet time.

We ask that you keep your site neat and tidy. This means all garbage is cleaned up. We would like to stress that the camp garbage bins are for your campground waste only, so keep your home garbage at home. We would also ask that you request permission to dispose of any construction or furniture garbage that you may have.
